Driver Training and GBN's new additions to the fleet

We are committed to investing in services and people to ensure that our customers continue to benefit from our strong customer-focused approach.

Our 150 vehicle fleet is expanding as GBN will be welcoming two new 'Euro V1 Mercedes Benz Arocs Skip Vehicles' and a new 8 wheel 'Euro V1 Mercedes Benz Arocs Dustcart' to our fleet in March 2014.

We place great importance on driver training and support a number of schemes. We have introduced the CSCS (Construction Skills Certification Scheme), which all of our drivers will have completed by March 2014. Twenty of our drivers are undertaking Crossrail Induction Training, a one day course educating drivers of the risks of driving in Central London alongside vulnerable road users such as cyclists. In addition we have on-going CPC Drivers' Training to improve road safety, provide better qualified drivers, and keep them up to date with any changes in legislation and to help reduce road casualties.

We are also delighted that two of our key staff, Andrew Supple at Leyton depot and Dave Brown at Southgate depot, have achieved their WAMITAB COTC qualification for technical competence in site waste management.
